INTRODUCTION

This report presents the Norm-Based Engagement activities that were carried out by ISS ESG on behalf of participating institutional investors during 2022.

The first section of the report provides an overview of the ISS ESG Norm-Based Engagement approach. This is followed by sections presenting overall engagement statistics for 2022, key engagement themes, as well as engagement outcomes including selected engagement spotlights. The report also a section covering details of dialogues held, unresponsive companies, as well as engagements that were closed in 2022. The final section of the report highlights companies unresponsive to long-standing controversies.

ISS ESG NORM-BASED ENGAGEMENT APPROACH

ISS ESG's Norm-Based Engagement facilitates engagement with issuers on behalf of participating investors who would like to encourage corporate disclosure of efforts taken to manage or mitigate the environmental and social risks connected to business activities or operations. By engaging collaboratively, participating asset owners and managers can wield more influence than through solo engagements, while saving time and resources.

ENGAGEMENT SCOPE

Through ISS ESG's Norm-Based Engagement, participating investors can focus on companies that are assessed under ISS ESG Norm-Based Research to be involved in alleged or verified severe, systematic, or systemic failures to respect international norms. The engagements are categorised under the four United Nations Global Compact areas of human rights, labour rights, environment, and anticorruption. Each engagement is identified by one or several specific topics within these areas, e.g., union rights, workplace discrimination, health and safety, child labour and forced labour within the labour rights norm area.

ENGAGEMENT PROCESS

The engagement is preceded by in-depth research and fact-finding dialogues with companies and stakeholders through ISS ESG Norm-Based Research. Once a company is identified to be involved in a relevant controversy it is considered for Norm-Based Engagement, which is conducted on a rolling quarterly basis. Through these feasibility studies, ISS ESG identifies gaps in company disclosure and assesses whether investor dialogue is an appropriate means to reach the goals set by the participating investors. Influential factors include an estimation of the company's level of responsibility, mitigating steps it has taken to mitigate the possible failure to respect a norm, and availability of both stakeholder and expert sources to facilitate constructive dialogue.

The engagement dialogue is initiated through letters to companies, sent by ISS ESG on behalf of participating investors. Dialogue may be conducted in writing or through calls and meetings, facilitated by ISS ESG. Some companies require repeated follow-ups to respond. Should the company remain unresponsive, enquiries are escalated to the CEO and the Board. Once every effort has been made to engage both Investor Relations and a company's Executive Management, the feasibility of engagement is re-evaluated.

ENGAGEMENT OUTCOMES

At the outset of each engagement, clear and actionable goals are defined within four key categories: disclosure, implementation, remediation and termination. Information provided by the company through the course of the engagement dialogue is assessed against the goals. ISS ESG also assesses the company's quality of participation in the engagement. Where the goals have been fulfilled and the controversy – or the risk thereof – is assessed to have been resolved, the engagement is closed. If there is insufficient information to determine whether the goals have been fulfilled, the engagement may be suspended pending developments in the controversy or the disclosure of further information by the company, and may subsequently be extended. Alternatively, where there is a poor outlook for the achievement of goals for the engagement, the dialogue may be discontinued.






ENGAGEMENT STATISTICS

During 2022 ISS ESG conducted Norm-Based Engagement on behalf of participating investors with 149 companies, covering 199 individual ESG topics. The companies engaged with are domiciled across 34 different locations. For 110 of the companies, a new engagement cycle was initiated during 2022. Some 70% of the 149 companies provided responses to the investor outreach.

ENGAGEMENT THEMES

This section outlines the key themes that Norm-Based Engagement related to during 2022. In the area of human rights, the key engagement topics were human rights due diligence and concerns regarding indigenous rights, especially related to stakeholder consultation. Workplace health and safety was the dominant labour rights theme, followed by union rights and forced labour/modern slavery. The majority of environment-focused engagement topics were related to corporate management of incidents of pollution (air, water, and soil), loss of biodiversity, and climate change. Within the area of anti-corruption, key engagement themes included bribery and anti-competitive behaviour.

The following table provides an overview of major engagement themes in 2022.

ENGAGEMENT OUTCOMES

One of the key outcomes of Norm-Based Engagement activity during 2022 is that participating investors elicited greater transparency from companies, marking a new record response rate of 70%. In most cases, improvements in disclosure and openness to dialogue were achieved gradually after persistent reminders and follow-up. Engagement success was achieved with companies which increased transparency, stopped a controversial practice, or announced a concrete and time-bound strategy for risk mitigation.

SELECTED ENGAGEMENT SPOTLIGHTS

The selected engagement spotlights below illustrate both successes and remaining work to be done in some of the major 2022 engagement themes, including human rights due diligence, forced labour and working conditions.

CoreCivic, Inc.

Human rights due diligence, Forced labour

Human rights due diligence, Forced labour

In Q3 2022, ISS ESG shared a letter with **CoreCivic, Inc.** on behalf of participating investors regarding the company's alleged failure to respect the right not to be subjected to inhumane and/or degrading treatment, and alleged failure to prevent forced labour, at correctional and detention centres in the United States.

In an engagement meeting facilitated by ISS ESG in October 2022, the company shared detailed information regarding its actions to stop the spread of COVID-19 at its facilities. Concerning measures to ensure that detainees are not subjected to inhumane and/or degrading treatment, the company highlighted its multi-level grievance process and mechanisms, available to all detainees and CoreCivic staff, the various authorities which conduct investigations into any allegations of human rights abuse, and the company's quality assurance audits which are based on 1,500 human rights indicators. ISS ESG notes the company's process to review grievances related to sexual assault allegations, and how it routinely tracks grievances to identify trends and interviews and surveys inmate populations for feedback on key areas. ISS ESG would have appreciated further disclosure on recent human rights issues identified through the grievance channels and through audits conducted at the facility.

ACTIVITY SUMMARY

Concerning the forced labour allegations, CoreCivic stated that it is limited in its ability to commission an independent investigation and share results publicly given that there is ongoing litigation. However, the company noted that it hired outside counsel to review and investigate the allegations and that its internal quality assurance team and ICE conduct frequent audits to evaluate if coerced labour is present in the company's facilities. ISS ESG notes CoreCivic's commitments in relation to human and labour rights at its facilities, such as updating and developing new policies and procedures. ISS ESG would have appreciated further

disclosure on the specific measures adopted by the company to address the allegations concerning conditions indicative of forced labour within its operations.

ISS ESG notes the details CoreCivic provided in this engagement dialogue, based on which the company was assessed to have made positive progress in the engagement goals with regard to implementation of relevant policies (Human Rights and Labour Rights controversy) as well as the disclosure of relevant information and remedial action (Labour Rights controversy). ISS ESG continues to monitor the efficacy of the company's commitments and remediation efforts to address the allegations.

In Q3 2021, ISS ESG shared a letter with **SIPEF SA/NV** on behalf of participating investors regarding the company's alleged failure to respect the right to just and favourable conditions of work in Indonesia.

In an engagement meeting facilitated by ISS ESG in February 2022, the company shared detailed information regarding its actions to address allegations of poor labour standards at its palm oil plantations in Indonesia. The company presented several remediation measures undertaken at the operations of its 95%-owned subsidiary PT Agro Kati Lama, such as through engagement with stakeholders – including the Roundtable on Responsible Palm Oil's (RSPO) Dispute Settlement Facility – and an independent third-party assessment into the allegations and of the company's policy commitments. Furthermore, the company elaborated on its labour rights policies regarding the health and safety, employment status, and pay in line with national policies.

ACTIVITY SUMMARY

Working conditions

ISS ESG notes the details SIPEF provided in this engagement dialogue, based on which the company was assessed to have made positive progress for all engagement goals, in particular with regard to remedial action. In August 2022, the underlying Norm-Based Research assessment was upgraded because in June 2022 a complaint raised through the RSPO was resolved and no new allegations have emerged against the company. ISS ESG holds this engagement to be an example of positive dialogue in which the company has demonstrated an openness and responsiveness to engagement and demonstrated that it has taken credible measures to address the allegations.

China

In Q2 2022, ISS ESG shared a letter with **Carrefour SA** on behalf of participating investors regarding the company's alleged failure (fragmentary information) to prevent forced labour in the supply chain in China.

In an engagement meeting facilitated by ISS ESG in September 2022, the company shared detailed information to address the allegations of forced labour in its supply chain. While Carrefour stated that it continues to source from allegedly controversial suppliers, it presented remediation measures that it is implementing in order to ensure there are no forced labour practices in its supply chain, such as through external investigation tools to identify non-compliance among its suppliers. Carrefour shared an example of its due diligence projects in spinning mills in its supply chain in India, where the company implemented a 'Worker Voice' system in 2020 to receive employee feedback on working conditions. Moreover, the company shared information regarding its evaluation of textile suppliers, including commercial, quality and delivery (supply chain) ratings. The company also initiated a mapping of its tier 2 suppliers in 2020 and aims to use all traceable and sustainable natural materials by 2030. Furthermore, Carrefour stated that it considers audits and self-assessments to be outdated processes, which are not sufficient and instead highlighted the importance of investigations. The company also collaborates with the NGO International Federation for Human Rights to prevent human rights abuses in its supply chain.

ACTIVITY SUMMARY

ISS ESG notes the details Carrefour provided in this engagement dialogue, based on which the company was assessed to have made positive progress in the engagement goals, in particular with regard to disclosure of relevant information. ISS ESG continues to monitor the efficacy of the company's commitments to address the allegations.





This change occurred because in June 2022, a complaint raised through the Roundtable on Sustainable Palm Oil (RSPO) in March 2021, alleging that SIPEF SA/NV's 95% owned subsidiary, PT Agro Kati Lama mostly employed casual workers, was resolved. Additionally, in communication with ISS ESG, SIPEF noted that the RSPO's Dispute Settlement Facility had initiated a grievance mediation process and that employees and unions had agreed to the remediation measures adopted by the company. As no new allegations have emerged against the company, ISS ESG assesses that this controversy is no longer current, leading to no further need for engagement at this time.

The identification also considered where the status for the engagement goals set for Norm-Based Engagement remain at 'no measures announced'. A further factor of consideration is the status of the controversies as well as fact-finding dialogue with the company conducted under Norm-Based Research.

For additional due diligence, investor clients may also want to consider companies with which engagement on specific topics has been discontinued, but where the controversy remains ongoing.²

The engagement has been suspended since April 2022.
