Annual Review of Pooled Engagement Activities for the period ending December 31, 2020







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INTRODUCTION

In 2020, ISS ESG was mandated to represent clients under the Pooled Engagement service in engagement on environmental, social, and governance issues with 142 companies covering 214 individual ESG topics, across 48 different locations.

ISS ESG's Pooled Engagement 2020 Annual Report presents an overview of all engagement activities carried out and summarizes the overall engagement progress and trends.

ISS ESG's Pooled Engagement service is focused on encouraging corporate disclosure of efforts taken to manage or mitigate the environmental and social risks connected to business activities or operations.

This next section describes the ISS ESG engagement approach, followed by a presentation of overall engagement statistics for 2020. Then this report includes a detailed account of all 2020 engagement activities undertaken on behalf of investors, comprising about 60 asset owners and managers representing more than USD 2.2 trillion in total assets under management.

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OUR ENGAGEMENT APPROACH

ISS ESG's Pooled Engagement service is focused on encouraging corporate disclosure of efforts taken to manage or mitigate the environmental and social risks connected to business activities or operations. The Pooled Engagement service enables participating asset owners and managers to wield more influence than through solo engagements, while saving time and resources.

INITIATING ENGAGEMENT

ISS ESG's Pooled Engagement service focuses on companies that are assessed under ISS ESG Norm-Based Research to be involved in alleged or verified severe, systematic or systemic failures to respect international norms. Engagement under the service is preceded by in-depth research and fact-finding dialogues with companies and stakeholders. Through these feasibility studies, ISS ESG identifies gaps in company disclosure and whether the desired level of disclosure can be achieved through investor dialogue. Influential factors include an estimation of the company's level of responsibility, steps it has taken to mitigate the possible failure to respect a norm, and availability of both stakeholder and expert sources to facilitate constructive dialogue.

At the outset of engagement, clear and actionable objectives are defined on the basis of expectations regarding the company's ability to address shortcomings in the context of its specific business sector and relevant industry standards. These objectives fall under four key categories (Disclosure, Implementation, Remediation, Termination) and progress is measured against four milestones (No measure announced, Commitment expressed, Measures initiated, Credible measures adopted).

Information provided by the company through the dialogue and interactions under the Pooled Engagement process are assessed against the objectives established at the outset of engagement and then a decision is taken on the outcome of the engagement. Where the fulfilment of the objectives has been met and a determination made that the controversy, or the risk thereof, has been resolved, the engagement will be closed. If there is insufficient information to determine whether the fulfillment of objectives have been met, the engagement will be extended. Alternatively, where there is a poor outlook for the achievement of objectives for the engagement, the engagement will be discontinued.

CONDUCTING EFFECTIVE ENGAGEMENT DIALOGUE

Pooled Engagement aims to build relationships that facilitate constructive dialogue, enabling investors to exercise their influence as owners. ISS ESG's Pooled Engagement approach encourages

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companies to elaborate on efforts taken to design and implement better risk management systems to minimize the risk for re-occurrence of failures to respect international norms. Through the service, information is sought on whether a company has proven successful in implementing a genuine reduction in risk.

ELICITING RESPONSES FROM NON-RESPONSIVE COMPANIES

Over time, responsiveness is noted with most companies with which engagement is sought. Others require repeated follow-ups to respond, and some steadfastly fail to respond to investor concerns. To address these challenges in communication, regular and courteous follow-up is built into the Pooled Engagement approach. Once every effort has been made to engage both Investor Relations and a company's Executive Management, the feasibility of engagement is re-evaluated.

Figure 2: Simplified Pooled Engagement timeline.


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


2020 ENGAGEMENT STATISTICS

During 2020 ISS ESG conducted Pooled Engagement on behalf of clients with 142 companies, covering 214 individual ESG topics. To assist investors with their reporting requirements, the statistics presented are derived from the engagement dialogues for which ISS ESG was conferred the mandate to act on investors' behalf during 2020.

ENGAGEMENT THEMES IN 2020

The engagements are categorized under the four United Nations (UN) Global Compact areas: human rights, labour rights, environment, and anti-corruption. Poor stakeholder consultation, and concerns regarding the right to life, especially related to consumer health, were the key topics under human rights. Workplace health and safety was the dominant labour rights theme, with union rights following. The majority of environment-focused engagements related to corporate management of incidences involving loss of biodiversity, as well as climate change and pollution (air, water and soil). For companies facing controversies on their anti-corruption management systems, engagement focused on their efforts to address reported incidences of bribery and money laundering.

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ACTIONS AND OUTCOMES OF 2020 ENGAGEMENTS

Through Pooled Engagement, participating investors elicited greater transparency from companies. In most cases, improvements in disclosure and openness to dialogue were achieved gradually after persistent reminders and follow-up. Engagement success was achieved with companies which increased transparency, stopped a controversial practice or announced a concrete and time-bound strategy for risk mitigation.

SELECTED ENGAGEMENT SPOTLIGHTS

The cases below illustrate some of the major 2020 engagement themes, including workplace health and safety, biodiversity depletion, climate change, bribery and union rights. They portray both successes and remaining work to be done.

JBS SA

The meat sector faced stakeholder criticism in 2020 regarding protecting its workforce from COVID-19-related risks. Meat processing plants were frequently hotspots of coronavirus-related infections and deaths, given that much of the work involves employees closely laboring on fast-moving production lines. As part of the Q4 2020 Pooled Engagement cycle, ISS ESG initiated a dialogue with Brazilian meat processor JBS SA on the topic of working conditions at its U.S. facilities amid the pandemic. In response, the company highlighted such supportive actions as removing medically vulnerable employees – including workers over 65 years old – from its U.S. facilities. Also, JBS commissioned three third-party organizations to review and supplement its COVID-19 prevention and mitigation strategies and said it implemented all recommendations provided by these consultants. This investor dialogue also raised the topic of allegations by multiple stakeholders of JBS sourcing cattle from suppliers involved in illegal deforestation in the Brazilian Amazon rainforest. JBS responded by noting such programs as Together for the Amazon, a range of long-term initiatives aimed at increasing conservation and development of the biome by engaging the entire industry. Pillars of this program include the JBS Green Platform, a blockchain-based tool will enable the company to extend to other links in its production chain the same socioenvironmental monitoring already applied to its direct suppliers in the Amazon. Although the Amber signals remain on these controversies, ISS ESG holds the working conditions engagement as an active of positive dialogue. However, ISS ESG has been engaging with JBS on Amazon deforestation since 2012 and while the company has demonstrated an openness and responsiveness to engagement on this topic it still has not taken enough action to end this controversy.

RWE AG

In November 2020, ISS ESG revised the Norm-Based Research signal for German energy company RWE AG (RWE) to Green from Amber, an assessment that dated back to November 2018. RWE faced criticism for its decision to extend the Hambach lignite mine in North Rhine Westphalia, Germany; NGOs and media reports stated that expanding this fossil fuel source to fuel the company's power stations was contrary to Germany's long-term plans to combat climate change. Furthermore, the mine's extension depended on clearing half of the remaining Hambach forest, which stakeholders call one of the oldest mixed forests in Europe with a unique ecosystem. In a May 2020 investor dialogue, RWE confirmed that, as part of then-pending legislation to end coal-fired power generation in Germany, it had reached an agreement with the government to preserve the forest.

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Then in November 2020, RWE informed ISS ESG that the coal-exit law had been approved by the German legislature, enshrining the protection of the forest. Furthermore, the company stated that it had completed a carbon emissions inventory, committed to a science-based emissions target in line with the Paris Agreement, and reviewed the climate alignment of its industry associations. Considering that the Hambach forest is protected and the company has committed to curbing emissions, as well as to achieve carbon neutrality by 2040, ISS ESG deems the controversy to be resolved and closed this engagement in November 2020.

Samsung Electronics Co., Ltd.

In 2020, investors, supported by ISS ESG, continued engaging with Samsung Electronics Co. Ltd., regarding the longstanding topic of bribery in South Korea, assessed as Red under Norm-Based Research, along with more recent allegations of the company's failure to respect union rights in South Korea, an Amber-signaled controversy. In investor dialogues during 2020, Samsung described measures initiated to address bribery since Samsung Vice Chairman Jay Y. Lee was sentenced to five years imprisonment in 2017 for paying KRW8.6 billion in bribes; these steps included strengthening the Corporate Compliance Team and the role of the Chief Compliance Officer, and launching an independent Compliance Committee. Furthermore, in March 2020 Samsung appointed an Independent Director as Chairman of the Board for the first time. Based on such actions, in January 2021 the Norm-Based Research assessment was upgraded to Amber and ISS ESG continues to monitor this topic for engagement. Separately, during the 2020 engagement dialogue Samsung highlighted recent efforts to help ensure that the company respects workers' rights to freedom of association and collective bargaining. Among these steps are worker rights training for all employees; workers' rights audits of its South Korean operations; and the 2018 recruitment of a human rights experts to be the company's global labor and human resources director. ISS ESG acknowledges the company's openness to dialogue and positive progress on these topics and has suspended these engagements pending further developments.
